### Public Session/Applications

- **Amber Cook presented an application on behalf of the Somers Point Sharks** for a Family Fun Day/Football Tournament on August 1<sup>st</sup> at Kern Field. The Commission directed Ms. Cook that outside vendors need to provide insurance for their booths. Application approved unanimously.
